Winnipeg's urban population of 60,000 Natives also need the gospel. Eventually Radio Ministry will expand to a tropical designated band.

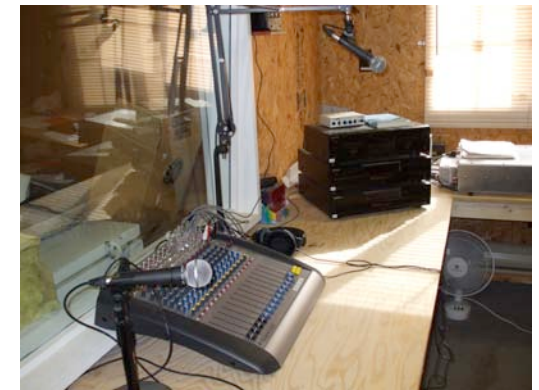
